The Glenwood Parent Teacher Association (PTA) serves the entire Glenwood community - students, teachers and families. Our mission is to help improve the educational opportunities for both students and teachers and to contribute to the general welfare of Glenwood families by raising funds that augment the school budget.

Fundraising via “Gator Giving”

The Glenwood PTA primarily fundraises through a **direct-donation campaign** called “Gator Giving.” Taking place early in the year (and assuming our goal is met), it allows events that take place later in the year to focus more on fun than on fundraising. Gator Giving launches in August. This handbook will review all the items that this campaign funds.



Book Fair

Glenwood PTA helps organize one Book Fair each Fall. During the fair, children's books are available for purchase in the Media Center before and after school, with the majority of the proceeds going to the of purchase books for the library and classrooms.

Teacher Support

From snacks each quarter to school supplies and a fund to reimburse for specific expenses, the PTA helps our teachers provide the best educational environment for our students. The district funding literally provides the space so our funding helps create a friendly and welcoming environment. And our Sunshine Committee frequently treats teachers and staff to goodies so that they know how much they are appreciated.

Room Parent - You may also receive emails from your child's Room Parent several times throughout the year as this parent coordinates class events and keeps the class updated on volunteer opportunities.

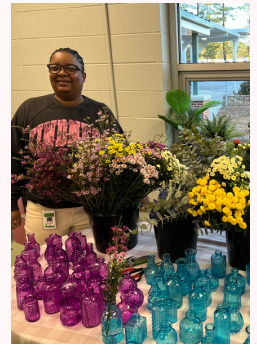
